COURSE DESCRIPTION

NEW FOR 2012

Level IV Sniper – Mixed Terrain Target Interdiction and Close Team Support

New for 2012, this innovative course was written with input of members of the High Ground Training Group and snipers from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. For too long, the police sniper training model has been stuck in a Post-Vietnam era training model and the tactics taught in sniper courses too often hamstring the sniper causing a misconception of the sniper's abilities and flexibility in missions. The Level IV course teaches the experienced sniper concepts in modern urban tactics by providing a detailed review of some of the high profile terrorist events of the last decade. Engagement of targets with both the .308 and the 5.56 mm weapon systems will be explored as well as the concepts of the mobile sniper team. This exciting course requires a high level of fitness as well as strong fundamental shooting skills. This course has been submitted to the Tennessee POST Commission as a Law Enforcement Specialized School. **This is an extremely physical course and participants must be in good physical condition!**

5 ½ Days, extended hours

Applicant must have completed recognized Basic and Advanced Sniper Courses prior to enrolling in the Level II Advanced Sniper Course.

It is recommended that students attend the SPS / HGTG Level II Sniper Course prior to enrolling in this course.

Only Police S.W.A.T. Snipers and Military Special Operations personnel will be considered for this course.

Course positions will not be held without registration and payment arrangements - so we must have a registration completed and on file. Payment must be made to the WCSO no later than 30 days prior to the course.

WCSO Cancellation & Refund Policy: If you decide after paying your fees in full that you cannot take the class for some reason, we will apply those fees toward another class in the same calendar year. If you decide you do not want to take another class, we will refund 50% of your paid course fee by request only.

Course cancellations within 14 days of the course will result in forfeiture of the tuition fees.

Course Requirements

- ⊕ All Courses require 100% student participation for completion. Students should clear their court calendars prior to registration for these courses.
- ⊕ Level I, Level II and Level IV courses require both live fire qualification and written exam passing scores for successful completion.
- ⊕ Level III course requires written examination and practical exercise participation for successful completion.

LEVEL IV SNIPER COURSE APPLICATION EQUIPMENT LIST

Each trainee will need the following:

- ⊕ Match Grade Sniper Rifle equipped with Optical Sight, Bipod and Sling in .308 Winchester or .223 Remington (5.56) (any other caliber must be approved prior to reporting for training)
- ⊕ Quality Optical Sight with ranging reticle – Mil Dot or equivalent
- ⊕ 350 rounds .308 ammunition
- ⊕ M-4 or equivalent battle rifle (5.56) with optical sight
- ⊕ Minimum of 3 magazines for 5.56 weapon
- ⊕ 500 rounds 5.56mm ammunition
- ⊕ Duty Handgun with tactical holster and a minimum of 3 magazines
- ⊕ 200 rounds handgun ammunition
- ⊕ Spotting Scope with Tripod and Binoculars
- ⊕ Operational Uniform (recommend camouflage BDUs)
- ⊕ Headgear (recommend “boonie” style hat)
- ⊕ Hydration system
- ⊕ Load bearing vest as issued by department with duty belt and sidearm
- ⊕ Appropriate Cold and Wet Weather gear for the season
- ⊕ Eye and Ear Protection
- ⊕ Pen and Pencil
- ⊕ Pocket Notebook
- ⊕ Weapon Cleaning Gear
- ⊕ Insect repellent and sunscreen
- ⊕ Knife – Fixed blade or folding tactical
- ⊕ Multi-plier tool
- ⊕ Pruning shear and/or portable saw
- ⊕ Sunscreen
- ⊕ Extra Boots and Gloves in case of wet weather
- ⊕ Ground cloth or shooting mat
- ⊕ Classroom appropriate attire for Day I & II
- ⊕ Note taking Supplies

Course Cadre

Senior Instructor: Denny R. Elliott is a 19 year veteran of law enforcement. He served nine seasons with the Kentucky Governor's Marijuana Strike Force where he served with a county wide element of a multiagency eradication team. He spent his last five years on the team as a Sniper and Sniper team leader. He served with a federal law enforcement agency where he developed the Tactical Marksman Program and oversaw the development of a tactical unit. He has acted as a consultant for other police departments in the area of patrol rifle. Denny served as the Tennessee state representative for the American Society of Law Enforcement Trainers (ASLET) for four years and is a member of the American Sniper Association, the National Tactical Officers' Association and the International Association of Law Enforcement Firearms Instructors. He is a certified instructor in Firearms, Tactical Rifle, Force on Force, Defensive Tactics, Baton and Edged Weapons. He currently serves as a deputy for the Williamson County Sheriff's Office working as a patrol deputy, S.W.A.T. Training Officer and Sniper. He developed the Level I, II, III and IV Police Sniper Courses which are owned by Sniper Pro Shop and presented by the High Ground Training Group.
