COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

TACTICAL HANDGUN OPERATOR

The L.E. Handgun Operator Course is designed to improve the skills of the officer with his issued firearm. Officers will be introduced to the Responsive and Intentional Deployment weapons concepts and will learn techniques and tactics to improve his chances of not only surviving, but also winning a deadly force encounter. The course will include force-on-force scenario based training.



TACTICAL RIFLE OPERATOR

The Tactical Rifle Operator Course is a flexible course designed to enhance the weapon handling skills of police personnel who have rifles assigned to them as primary shoulder fired weapons. The course stresses team and partner concepts as well as abilities and limitations of the law enforcement rifle. The course will provide tactical training concepts for both Patrol and Special Operations Officers. The course will include force-on-force scenario based training.

2 days, 16 hours

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- All Courses require 100% student participation for completion. Students should clear their court calendars prior to registration for these courses.
 - Trainee must agree to abide by the rules of the course and the host agency range. Unsafe acts will not be tolerated and can result in the trainee being expelled from the course.

Duty Handgun

500 rounds training ammunition.

Minimum 3 magazines and duty belt.

EQUIPMENT LIST for TACTICAL RIFLE OPERATOR COURSE

Rifle (AR-15 system preferred)

500 rounds rifle ammunition. FMJ 55 grain or department issue load. No armor piercing or green tip ammunition should be used.

150 rounds pistol training ammunition.

Duty handgun, magazines and duty belt.

Belt or drop-leg rifle magazine pouch.

20 or 30 round rifle magazines (minimum 3 each)

Force-on-Force Scenario training in all courses will be done with Airsoft weapons. Students may opt to bring their own airsoft weapon system to the course for use. No enhanced Airsoft weapon systems will be allowed. Limited airsoft systems will be provided by SPS and the WCSO.

CADRE

Course Cadre

Senior Instructor: Denny R. Elliott is a 19 year veteran of law enforcement. He served nine seasons with the Kentucky Governor's Marijuana Strike Force where he served with a county wide element of a multiagency eradication team. He spent his last five years on the team as a Sniper and Sniper team leader. He served with a federal law enforcement agency where he developed the Tactical Marksman Program and oversaw the development of a tactical unit. He has acted as a consultant for other police departments in the area of patrol rifle. Denny served as the Tennessee state representative for the American Society of Law Enforcement Trainers (ASLET) for four years and is a member of the American Sniper Association, the National Tactical Officers' Association and the International Association of Law Enforcement Firearms Instructors. He is a certified instructor in Firearms, Tactical Rifle, Force on Force, Defensive Tactics, Baton and Edged Weapons. He currently serves as a deputy for the Williamson County Sheriff's Office working as a patrol deputy, S.W.A.T. Training Officer and Sniper. He developed the Level I, II ,III and IV Police Sniper Courses which are owned by Sniper Pro Shop and presented by the High Ground Training Group.
